### *Multi-stakeholder Forum on Sustainable Energy in Zambia*

*Joining forces for Sustainable Energy*

The **Energy Access Work Stream** of the [Africa-EU Energy Partnership](#) is delighted to announce a day-long Dialogue Event on Sustainable Energy and Energy Access to be hosted jointly by the Ministry of Energy of Zambia and the [Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa](#) (COMESA).

The event provides an opportunity to discuss progress on Zambia's SE4All Action Agenda and Investment Prospectus, and to identify specific opportunities for strengthening multi-stakeholder partnerships to achieve the three goals of SE4All.

The event will focus on the Zambian national context, **but will bring in expertise and share experiences from across the Southern African region**.
